**PROBLEM:** EHD (EPIZOOTIC HEMORRHAGIC DISEASE) and BT (BLUETONGUE VIRUS) are some of the most common diseases among Whitetail Deer. Once infected with EHD/BT, deer typically die within 5 and 10 days. Outbreaks of EHD/BT tend to hit in late summer and early fall and the prevalence likelihood can increase based on certain types of weather. Whitetail deer that have been infected by EHD/BT tend to appear disoriented, lethargic, lame, and unresponsive while progressive symptoms are excessive drooling, mouth sores, and swollen blue tongues.

**THE CAUSE:** BITING MIDGES. Biting Midges live in or near water and wet, muddy areas. Midges carry this disease and transmit to the population through feeding. Once the deer comes within proximity of a Midges' living space, the Midge will attack. Biting Midges are a life threat to all Whitetail Deer.
